BY THE COMMISSION: On October 5, 2018, the Commission issued an order in the above-referenced dockets. It has come to the Commission's attention that changes to Attachment 8 – Facilities Study Agreement, as spelled out in the Public Staff's filing dated September 19, 2018, were inadvertently missing from Appendix A and B of the order. The new paragraph 11 of Attachment 8 – Facilities Study Agreement of the North Carolina Interconnection Procedures, Forms and Agreements shall be as follows:

ATTACHMENT 8 – Facilities Study Agreement

11. If the Interconnection Customer submitted prepayment or Financial Security reasonably acceptable to the Utility for Network Upgrades under Section 4.3.9 of the North Carolina Interconnection Procedures, the Parties agree that this prepayment or Financial Security shall be held by the Utility as a non-refundable prepayment for the estimated cost of Network Upgrades and Interconnection Customer expressly agrees this prepayment amount shall be forfeited to the Utility to construct the Network Upgrades if the Interconnection Request is subsequently withdrawn. The Network Upgrades prepayment amount shall be trued up by the Utility in the Detailed Estimated Upgrade Charges amount calculated during Facilities Study and identified in a Facilities Study report to be included in a future Interconnection Agreement.

The Commission, therefore, finds good cause to issue this Errata Order.
