AND NECESSITY NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on March 16, 2015, Bullock Solar, LLC (Applicant), filed an application seeking a certificate of public convenience and necessity pursuant to G.S. 62-110.1(a) for construction of a 50-MW solar generating facility to be located on the south side of Wilson Brother Road, on the west side of Jacksontown Road, and across from Culpepper Road in Manson, Vance County, North Carolina. The Applicant plans to sell the electricity to Duke Energy Progress, Inc.
