BY THE CHAIR: On October 4, 2019, the Commission issued an Order Granting Additional Extension of Time to File Reply Comments in response to a motion filed by Duke Energy Progress, LLC (DEP), and Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC (DEC, collectively Duke) in the above-captioned dockets. The Order granted all parties an extension of time to December 6, 2019, to file reply comments regarding the demand-side management and energy efficiency (DSM/EE) mechanisms by which DEP and DEC recover their DSM/EE costs and incentives.

On December 3, 2019, Duke filed a motion requesting that the date for reply comments be further extended to December 20, 2019. In summary, Duke stated that a further extension of time will allow the parties to continue meeting and working toward resolution of some or all of the issues. In addition, Duke listed a number of parties that it contacted about its proposed extension of time to file reply comments, being those parties who filed initial comments, and stated that they have no objection to the proposed further extension of time.

Based on Duke's motion and the record, the Chair finds good cause to extend to December 20, 2019, the date for parties to file reply comments on Duke's DSM/EE mechanisms.

IT IS, THEREFORE, SO ORDERED.
