BY THE CHAIRMAN: On March 29, 2018, the Commission issued an Order scheduling the above-captioned docket for hearing and establishing procedural deadlines. Pursuant to that Order, the testimony of the Public Staff and other intervenors is due on May 21, 2018, and the reply testimony of Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC (DEC) is due on May 31, 2018.

On May 21, 2018, the Public Staff, the North Carolina Justice Center and the Southern Alliance for Clean Energy, (Petitioners) filed a motion requesting that all intervenors be granted an extension to May 22, 2018, to file testimony, and that DEC be granted an extension to June 1, 2018, to file reply testimony. In support of its motion, the Public Staff states that because of the press of work and other factors the Public Staff needs additional time to complete its testimony.

Based on the Petitioners' motion and the record herein, the Chairman finds good cause to grant the Petitioners' motion to extend the due date to file their testimony in this docket to May 22, 2018, and to extend the due date for DEC to file reply testimony to June 1, 2018.

IT IS, THEREFORE, SO ORDERED.
