BY THE CHAIR: On August 16, 2022, Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC (DEC), filed an application in the above-captioned docket for approval of its proposed Electric Vehicle Load Control Service Pilot (Vehicle-to-Grid) pilot program as a new demand-side management (DSM) program.

Pursuant to Commission Rule R8-68(d)(2), after an electric public utility files a request for approval or modification of a DSM or energy efficiency program the Public Staff and other interested parties have 30 days from the date of filing to file a protest pursuant to Rule R1-6, a petition for intervention pursuant to Rule R1-19, or comments. The electric public utility has the opportunity to respond to the petitions for intervention, protests and comments within 10 days.

On September 13, 2022, the Public Staff filed a motion requesting that the Commission extend the time for filing protests, interventions and comments on DEC's proposed Vehicle-to-Grid pilot program to November 14, 2022. The Public Staff stated that due to the press of other business, and particularly its involvement in the Duke Carbon Plan hearings in Docket No. E-100, Sub 179, the Public Staff needs additional time to prepare and file its comments. The Public Staff further stated that it had conferred with DEC, and that DEC has no objection to the requested extension of time.

Based on the Public Staff's motion and the record in the docket, the Chair finds good cause to grant the requested extension of time for the Public Staff and other interested parties.

## IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED as follows:

1. That the date for the Public Staff and other interested parties to file a protest, petition for intervention or comments in this docket regarding DEC's proposed Vehicle-to-Grid pilot program shall be, and is hereby, extended to November 14, 2022; and

2. That DEC shall have the right to respond to all such petitions for intervention, protests and comments within 10 days of each such filing.
