BY THE CHAIRMAN: On February 26, 2009, the Commission issued its Order Resolving Certain Issues, Requesting Information on Unsettled Matters, and Allowing Proposed Rider to Become Effective Subject to Refund in the above-identified docket. That order required, among other things, Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC (Duke) to provide supplemental information and calculations regarding eight cost and incentive scenarios. All parties were to file comments on Duke's supplemental information by May 1, 2009, and Duke was to file its reply comments by May 18, 2009.

On March 31, 2009, Duke filed its required supplement information.

On April 29, 2009, the Attorney General's Office (AG) filed a motion requesting an extension of time from May 1, 2009, to May 22, 2009, for all parties to file comments regarding Duke's supplemental information and an extension of time from May 18, 2009, to June 12, 2009, for Duke to file its reply comments. That motion was granted by order issued May 6, 2009.

On May 21, 2009, the Public Staff and the Southern Environmental Law Center (SELC), Environmental Defense Fund (EDF), Natural Resources Defense Council (NRDC), and Southern Alliance for Clean Energy (SACE), filed a joint motion requesting an extension of time from May 22, 2009, to May 29, 2009, for all parties to file comments regarding Duke's supplemental information and an extension of time from June 12, 2009, to June 19, 2009, for Duke to file its reply comments. The Public Staff states that it has been diligently reviewing Duke's supplemental filing and that it has sought additional information from Duke relating to this filing. Duke has recently provided this information to the Public Staff, but, due to the press of other business, the Public Staff has been unable to complete its review. The Public Staff asserts that SELC, EDF, NRDC, and SACE join in this motion and that Duke does not object to this request.

The Chairman finds good cause to grant the requested extension of time as requested.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED as follows:

- 1. That the deadline by which parties may file comments on Duke's supplemental information shall be, and hereby is, extended to and including May 29, 2009; and
- 2. That the deadline for Duke to file reply comments shall be, and hereby is, extended to and including June 19, 2009.
