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BY THE CHAIR: On July 13, 2020, the Commission issued its Order Granting Further Extension of Time, extending until August 15, 2020, the time for parties in the docket to file reply comments on the queue reform proposal of Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC (DEC), and Duke Energy Progress, LLC (DEP), (jointly, Duke).

Duke filed its queue reform proposal on May 15, 2020. On June 15, 2020, North Carolina Clean Energy Business Alliance (NCCEBA), North Carolina Clean Energy Business Alliance (NCCEBA), GreenGo Energy US, Inc. (GreenGo), and the Public Staff filed comments on the Proposal.

On August 6, 2020, Duke, NCCEBA and NCSEA (Movants) filed a Joint Motion for Additional Extension of Time to File Reply Comments on Queue Reform Proposal requesting the Commission provide an extension of time for all parties to file reply comments on Duke's proposal. In support of its motion Movants state that while parties have made significant progress in reaching consensus, due to the complexity of the issue the parties would like additional time to reach full consensus prior to filing reply comments.

The Movants further state that the Public Staff supports the motion, and that Dominion Energy North Carolina and GreenGo do not object to the motion.


After consideration of the record and in the interest of allowing the parties to achieve full consensus, the Chair finds good cause to grant this motion to extend the time for parties in the docket to file reply comments on Duke's queue reform proposal to August 31, 2020.
