BY THE CHAIR: On August 4, 2022, Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC (DEC), and Duke Energy Progress, LLC (DEP, and collectively with DEC, Duke), filed a Joint Motion for Extension of Time to File Supplemental Reply Comments, requesting a 30-day extension to the filing deadline. Duke states that it has been working diligently on its supplemental reply comments but explains that due to certain parties' addition of new revisions to previously proposed rules, as well as considerations for new processes for implementation, and the press of other matters, the Companies require additional time to complete their supplemental reply comments. Duke also states that the requested extension will not result in prejudice to any party and that counsel for Duke has contacted counsel for the other parties and no party objects.

Based on the foregoing and the record, the Chair finds good cause to grant the motion and extend the time in which the parties are required or permitted to file supplemental reply comments. The parties may file supplemental reply comments on or before Wednesday, September 7, 2022.
