BY THE CHAIR: On October 6, 2022, Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC (DEC), and Duke Energy Progress, LLC (DEP, and collectively with DEC, Duke), filed a Joint Motion for Extension of Time to File Supplemental Reply Comments, requesting a 60-day extension to the filing deadline. Duke states that since the filing of its and other parties' prior motions for extensions of time, those parties have continued to engage in discussions to see if agreement can be reached on the treatment of requests for disclosure of aggregated customer data and additional time is needed for further discussions. Duke also states that the requested extension will not result in prejudice to any party and that counsel for Duke has contacted counsel for the other parties and no party objects.

Based on the foregoing and the record, the Chair finds good cause to grant the motion and extend the time in which the parties are permitted to file supplemental reply comments. The parties may file supplemental reply comments on or before Tuesday, December 6, 2022.
