NOW COME Duke Energy Progress, LLC ("DEP"), Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC ("DEC"), and Piedmont Natural Gas Company, Inc. ("Piedmont") (collectively "the Companies"), by and through counsel and pursuant to Rule R1-9 of the North Carolina Utilities Commission ("Commission") Rules and Regulations, and jointly request a sixmonth extension of time to perform the comprehensive market competitiveness study required by Regulatory Condition No. 5.2(b), which was most recently approved in the *Order Granting Motion to Amend Regulatory Conditions*, issued on August 24, 2018 in Docket Nos. E-2, Sub 1095A, E-7, Sub 1100A and G-9, Sub 682A. In support, the Companies show the following:

1. Regulatory Condition 5.2(b) requires DEC, DEP and Piedmont to perform a comprehensive, non-solicitation based assessment of the market competitiveness of the costs for goods and services provided by any of them to a Utility Affiliate, Duke Energy Business Services, a Non-Utility Affiliate, any other Affiliate, and a Nonpublic Utility Operation every four years.

2. The prior market competitiveness study began in 2016 and was filed on January 13, 2017. Due to the Companies' focus on the independent third-party audit of affiliate transactions, which began earlier this year and remains pending before the Commission, the Companies need additional time to conduct a new market competitiveness study.

3. The Companies jointly request, therefore, an additional six months to conduct the market competitiveness study, with a target filing date of May 1, 2021. As with the 2017 market competitiveness study, the Companies intend to consult with the Public Staff on how the market study will be conducted to gain its input. The Companies have provided a copy of this joint motion to the Public Staff before filing, and it had no objection to the requested extension.

WHEREFORE, the Companies respectfully request that the Commission grant an extension until May 1, 2021 to conduct and file the market competitiveness study and any such further relief as the Commission deems just and proper.
