Comes now Enerwise Global Technologies, LLC, d/b/a CPower Energy Management ("CPower") to request withdrawal of its petition to intervene in the above-captioned proceeding. In support of this request, CPower states:

- 1. CPower filed a petition to intervene in this matter on December 22, 2022, which has not been ruled upon.

 the general policies toward demand response in North Carolina.

 to this proceeding.
- 4. CPower does not have a position or view toward the disposition of the specific question presented in this proceeding, to wit, the compliance determination by the Commission of a newly enacted demand response standard under the Public Utility Regulatory Policies Act of 1978. Accordingly, CPower does not have a need or desire to participate as a formal party in this proceeding.

WHEREFORE, CPower requests that the Commission allow CPower to withdraw its petition to intervene in this proceeding, and for such other and further relief as this cause may require.
