BY THE PRESIDING COMMISSIONER: On December 15, 2023, the Commission issued an Order Accepting Stipulations, Granting Partial Rate Increase, Requiring Public Notice, and Modifying Lincoln CT CPCN Conditions (Rate Case Order).

On December 28, 2023, the Carolina Industrial Group for Fair Utility Rates III (CIGFUR), Blue Ridge Electric Membership Corporation, Haywood Electric Membership Corporation, Piedmont Electric Membership Corporation, and Rutherford Electric Membership Corporation (collectively, Movants) jointly filed a Motion for Extension of Time to File Appeal pursuant to N.C. Gen. Stat. § 62-90 and Commission Rule R1-7 requesting an extension of time to February 13, 2024, to file a notice of appeal to the Rate Case Order (Motion). In support of the Motion, the Movants state that they require more time to evaluate the impact of the Rate Case Order.

Based on the Motion and the record as a whole, the Presiding Commissioner finds good cause to allow the requested extension of time.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED that all parties shall have an extension of time up to and including February 13, 2024, to file notice of appeal to the Rate Case Order.
