Pursuant to North Carolina General Statutes ("N.C. Gen. Stat.") § 84-4.1 and Rule R1-22 of the North Carolina Utilities Commission (the "Commission") Rules of Practice and Procedure, J. WHEREFORE, Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC and Duke Energy Progress, LLC respectfully request that this Motion be granted and that J. Ashley Cooper be allowed to appear before the Commission in this matter.
