BY THE CHAIR: On October 13, 2021, the Governor signed into law House Bill 951 (S.L. 2021-165). Section 5 of the S.L. 2021-165 authorizes the Commission to establish rules by April 11, 2022, for the securitization of costs associated with the early retirement of subcritical coal-fired generating facilities.

The Chair finds good cause to request comments and proposed rules on the securitization of costs associated with the early retirement of subcritical coal-fired generating facilities.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED as follows:

1. That Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC, and Duke Energy Progress, LLC, are hereby made parties to this docket without the necessity of filing petitions to intervene.
2. That any other persons desiring to become formal parties to this proceeding may file a petition to intervene on or before November 22, 2021;
3. That parties may file comments and proposed rules on or before November 22, 2021; and
4. That parties may file reply comments on or before December 20, 2021.
