P R O C E E D I N G S

HEARING EXAMINER JEFFRIES: Let's go on the record now. My name is Nicholas Jeffries. I am a Hearing Examiner with the North Carolina Utilities Commission, and I have been assigned to hear this case today. It is 10:08 a.m. on Friday, March 31st, 2023, and we are in Commission Hearing Room 2115, Raleigh, North Carolina.

I now call for hearing Docket No. T-4885, Sub 0, Supreme Movers, LLC, hereinafter referred to as Respondent or Supreme Movers, of 10105 Fallon Farm Road, Apartment 103, Charlotte, North Carolina 28278, In the Matter of Revocation of Certificate of Exemption No. C-3015 for Failure to Attend the Commission Required Maximum Rate Tariff Training Seminar no later than three months from the issuance of Respondent's Certificate of Exemption on June 8th, 2022.

The Commission's official file reflects that on April 29th, 2022, Respondent filed with the Commission an Application for a Certificate of Exemption.

On June 8th, 2022, the Commission issued an Order Granting Application for Certificate of

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1 Exemption, authorizing Supreme Movers, LLC, to
2 transport household goods between all points and
3 places within North Carolina under Certificate of
4 Exemption No. C-3015. Among other things, the Order
5 requires "that the Applicant shall attend an online
6 Maximum Rate Tariff (MRT) training seminar no later
7 than (3) months from the date of this Order", which
8 was a June 8th, 2022 Order, and that was in Ordering
9 Paragraph No. 5.

10 On December 7th, 2022, the Public Staff
11 notified Commission Staff that Supreme Movers, LLC,
12 had not attended any of the MRT training seminars held
13 since its certification on June 8th, 2022.

14 On January 12th, 2023, Commission Staff
15 issued a certified letter addressed to Wilman Rojas,
16 owner of Supreme Movers, LLC, notifying him that
17 either he or a representative for Supreme Movers is
18 required to attend the next scheduled MRT training
19 seminar or the Commission would have no other option
20 but to suspend Supreme Movers, LLC's, Certificate of
21 Exemption.

22 On January 31st, 2023, the Public Staff
23 notified Commission Staff that Supreme Movers, LLC,
24 failed to attend the next scheduled MRT training

1 seminar which was held on January 26th, 2023.

2 On February 9th, 2023, the Commission issued
3 an Order Suspending Certificate of Exemption for
4 Failure to Attend the MRT Seminar. Among other
5 things, the Order required Supreme Movers, LLC, to
6 attend the next MRT training seminar, which was
7 scheduled to be held online on February 21st, 2023, in
8 order to prevent the suspension of its Certificate of
9 Exemption on February 22nd, 2023. In the alternative,
10 the Order also required Supreme Movers' appearance
11 before the Commission to show cause why its
12 Certificate of Exemption should not be revoked for
13 failure to comply with the Commission's Order.

14 On February 22nd, 2023, Public Staff
15 notified Commission Staff that Supreme Movers failed
16 to attend the February 21st, 2023, MRT seminar.

17 On March 2nd, 2023, the Commission issued an
18 Order requiring Respondent to appear before the
19 Commission on this day and at this time to show cause
20 why its Certificate of Exemption should not be revoked
21 for willful failure to attend a mandatory MRT training
22 seminar, as required by Ordering Paragraph No. 5 of
23 the June 8th, 2022, Order; and it should not be
24 subject to such penalty or other actions as the

1 Commission may impose pursuant to N.C. General Statute
2 § 62-310.

3 Let the record reflect that the Respondent
4 is not present nor is anyone present to appear on his
5 behalf. That being the case, the Commission will
6 issue the appropriate Order canceling the Respondent's
7 Certificate for willful failure to attend a mandatory
8 MRT training seminar, as required by Ordering
9 Paragraph No. 5 of the June 8th, 2022 Order.

10 This hearing is adjourned.
