ORDER GRANTING MOTION

BY THE CHAIR: On July 25, 2022, Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC (DEC); Duke Energy Progress, LLC (DEP); and the Public Staff (collectively, Movants) filed a Joint Motion requesting an additional 14 days in which to file with the Commission the Final Report of the Low-Income Affordability Collaborative (Report) in Docket Nos. E-7, Subs 1214, 1213, and 1187, and E-2, Subs 1219 and 1193. Movants explain that the Report is due to be filed with the Commission on or before July 29, 2022. Movants state that they have been working diligently to prepare the Report but need additional time to complete it. As such, Movants request that the Commission grant an additional 14 days, up to and including Friday, August 12, 2022, to file the Report.

Based on the foregoing and the record, the Chair finds good cause to grant the requested extension of time. The Companies shall file the Final Report of the Low-Income Affordability Collaborative on or before Friday, August 12, 2022.
