BY THE CHAIRMAN: On May 10, 2017, in the above-captioned docket, John W. Gensinger (Applicant) filed an application for rate increase with the Commission. On June 6, 2017, the Commission issued an Order declaring the proceeding to be a general rate case, suspending the proposed new rates for up to 270 days, and scheduling a public hearing for October 10, 2017, in Commission Hearing Room 2115, Dobbs Building, 430 North Salisbury Street, Raleigh, North Carolina. The hearing was scheduled subject to cancellation if no significant protests were received within 60 days after the date of the Order.

On August 30, 2017, the Applicant provided its certificate of service indicating that all customers have been served with notice of the proposed rate increase and hearing as required by the Commission's June 6, 2017 Order. No protests have been received.

On September 18, 2017, the Public Staff – North Carolina Utilities Commission (Public Staff) filed a Motion to Cancel Hearing. In its motion, the Public Staff stated that the Applicant has agreed to the Public Staff's recommended rates and that there are no longer any issues in dispute between the Applicant and the Public Staff. As a result, the Public Staff recommended that the hearing scheduled for October 10, 2017, be canceled.

On September 20, 2017, the Public Staff filed the affidavits of Iris Morgan, Accountant, Water Section, Accounting Division; Karen E. Proffitt, Utilities Engineer, Water and Sewer Division; and Calvin C. Craig, III, Financial Analyst, Economic Research Division.

Based upon the foregoing, the Chairman is of the opinion that the hearing scheduled for Tuesday, October 10, 2017, in Raleigh, North Carolina should be canceled and customer notice should be required.

IT IS THEREFORE, ORDERED as follows:

1. That the public hearing previously scheduled for Tuesday, October 10, 2017, in Commission Hearing Room 2115, Dobbs Building, 430 North Salisbury Street, Raleigh, North Carolina, is canceled.

2. That a copy of this Order shall be mailed with sufficient postage or hand delivered by John W. Gensinger to all customers in the above-captioned service area no later than September 29, 2017, and that the Applicant shall submit to the Commission the attached Certificate of Service, properly signed and notarized, no later than October 4, 2017.

3. That a further order of the Commission addressing the applied for rate increase shall be issued at a later date.
