	ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR
	EXTENSION OF TIME OF DUKE

BY THE CHAIR: On August 13, 2021, the Commission issued an Order Establishing Biennial Proceeding, Requiring Data, and Scheduling Public Hearing, which established deadlines for the filing of comments. On February 2, 2022, the North Carolina Sustainable Energy Association (NCSEA), Carolinas Clean Energy Business Alliance (CCEBA), and the Southern Alliance for Clean Energy (SACE) filed a joint motion for an extension of time through February 24, 2022, for parties to file initial comments and also for an extension of time through March 28, 2022, for parties to file reply comments, which motion was granted by the Commission on February 7, 2022.

On March 24, 2022, Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC (DEC), and Duke Energy Progress, LLC (DEP and together with DEC, Duke) filed a joint motion for an extension of time through April 1, 2022, for parties to file reply comments. In support of the motion, Duke states that they are working diligently to prepare their reply comments but require additional time to discuss certain matters to try to gain a better understanding and potentially reach consensus with other parties. Duke further states that their counsel has contacted counsel for all parties of record regarding the motion and that no party has objected to the motion.

Based on the foregoing, the Chair finds good cause to grant the motion.

IT IS, THEREFORE, SO ORDERED.
