Brobeck Solar Energy (BSE) supports all efforts to hyper-accelerate the installation of utility owned solar PV systems at customer owned facilities. BSE also wishes to collaborate with Duke Energy, the commission and their electric customers to improve North Carolina's energy efficiency programs by introducing the patented Energy Credit Card Payment System. The Energy Credit Card Payment System would allow Duke Energy to compensate all those participating in the Solar Distribution Program while at the same time encouraging those building owners to improve the energy efficiency of their buildings.

More specifically, instead of paying the building owners cash for leasing their roof space, Duke Energy would deposit these lease payments into the building owner's Energy Credit Card account. In the case of a low-income multi-family apartment complex, the lease payments would be dispersed to the building owner and the tenants. Each tenant would have their own Energy Credit Card account.

The Energy Credit Card is like a hyper affinity card with real money as a reward. But the energy credit card is also a discount card. BSE will arrange with local retailers to give additional discounts for energy related goods and services like double pane window, insulation, weather stripping, energy star appliances, mass transit tickets, natural gas or transportation fuels.
