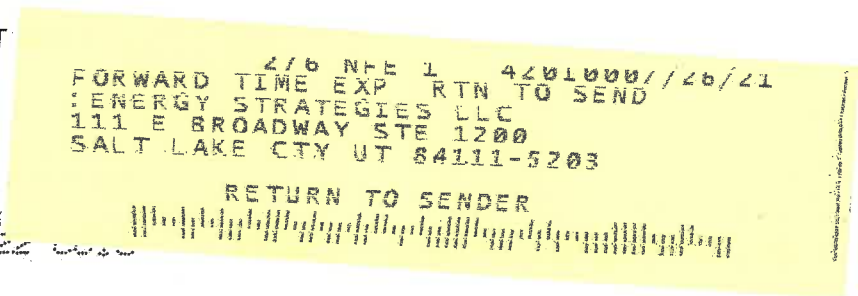
BY THE COMMISSION: On June 4, 2021, Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC, and Duke Energy Progress, LLC (collectively, Duke or the Companies), filed with the Commission an Update on the Collaborative on the Affordability of Electric Service for Low-Income Customers (Update). The Companies stated that they have worked with the North Carolina Justice Center (NCJC), the Public Staff, and the North Carolina Attorney General's Office (AGO) to identify a pool of potential participants with experience, interest, or both, in issues regarding the affordability of electric service for low-income customers. The Companies explained that they sent this pool of potential participants an email to solicit their participation in the Affordability Collaborative. The Companies further included a list of interested stakeholders and identified participants as Appendix A to the Update (Participant List) and briefly explained the stakeholders' interest.

On June 28, 2021, the Commission issued an Order Accepting Submitted Participant List for the Affordability Collaborative. Among other things, the Order
