BY THE COMMISSION: On October 14, 2014, the Commission issued an order granting a certificate of public convenience and necessity and accepting the registration statement for Hardison Farm Solar, LLC (Applicant), for construction of a 4.99-MW<sub>AC</sub> solar photovoltaic electric generating facility to be located at 19919 U.S. Highway 64, near Williamston, Martin County, North Carolina.

On August 5, 2015, and September 1, 2015, the Applicant filed letters with the Commission indicating that the facility will encompass an additional tract of land besides the one identified in its initial application.

On September 9, 2015, the Commission issued an Amended Order Requiring Publication of Notice.

On October 5, 2015, the Applicant filed a certificate of service stating that a copy of the initial application, amendment, and public notice were provided to Dominion North Carolina Power on October 2, 2015.

On October 20, 2015, the State Clearinghouse filed comments. Because of the nature of the comments, the cover letter indicated that no further State Clearinghouse review action by the Commission was required for compliance with the North Carolina Environmental Policy Act.

On November 5, 2015, the Applicant filed an affidavit of publication from the Williamston Enterprise stating that the publication of notice was completed on October 30, 2015. No complaints have been received.

The Public Staff presented this matter to the Commission at its Regular Staff Conference on April 4, 2016. The Public Staff stated that it had reviewed the amendment and determined it to be in compliance with the requirements of G.S. 62-110.1(a) and Commission Rule R8-64.

Based upon the foregoing, and the recommendation of the Public Staff, the Commission finds good cause to approve the amended application and issue the requested certificate.

#### IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED as follows:

- 1. That the application filed by Hardison Farm Solar, LLC, for an amended certificate of public convenience and necessity shall be, and is hereby, approved.
- 2. That Appendix A shall constitute the amended certificate of public convenience and necessity issued to Hardison Farm Solar, LLC, for the 4.99-MW $_{\rm AC}$  solar photovoltaic electric generating facility to be located at 19919 U.S. Highway 64, near Williamston, Martin County, North Carolina.
