BY THE CHAIRMAN: On February 20, 2015, Grandview Wind Farm, LLC (Grandview), filed a registration statement pursuant to Commission Rule R8-66 for a new renewable energy facility to be located in Panhandle in Carson County, Texas. Grandview stated that its 211.22-MW<sub>AC</sub> wind generating facility became operational on September 18, 2014.

The filing included certified attestations that: 1) the facility will be in substantial compliance with all federal and state laws, regulations, and rules for the protection of the environment and conservation of natural resources; 2) the facility will be operated as a new renewable energy facility; 3) Grandview will not remarket or otherwise resell any renewable energy certificates (RECs) sold to an electric power supplier to comply with G.S. 62-133.8; and 4) Grandview will consent to the auditing of its books and records by the Public Staff insofar as those records relate to transactions with North Carolina electric power suppliers.

On March 12, 2015, the Public Staff filed the recommendation required by Commission Rule R8-66(e) stating that Grandview's registration statement as a new renewable energy facility should be considered to be complete. No other party made a filing with respect to these issues.

Based upon the foregoing and the entire record in this proceeding, the Chairman finds good cause to accept registration of Grandview's wind generating facility as a new renewable energy facility. Grandview shall annually file the information required by Commission Rule R8-66 on or before April 1 of each year. Grandview will be required to participate in the NC-RETS REC tracking system ([www.ncrets.org](http://www.ncrets.org)) in order to facilitate the issuance of RECs.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED as follows:


1. That the registration by Grandview for its wind generating facility located in Panhandle in Carson County, Texas as a new renewable energy facility shall be, and is hereby, accepted.

2. That Grandview shall annually file the information required by Commission Rule R8-66 on or before April 1 of each year.
