BY THE CHAIRMAN: On May 20, 2013, the Commission issued an Order Granting Extensions of Time in the above-captioned docket rescheduling the dates for the filing of petitions to intervene and direct testimony and exhibits of the Public Staff and intervenors to May 24, 2013, and for the filing of rebuttal testimony by Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC (Duke), to May 31, 2013.

On May 23, 2013, the Public Staff filed a Motion for Extension of Time requesting that the date for the filing of petitions to intervene and intervenor testimony be extended to May 31, 2013, and that the date for the filing of Duke's rebuttal testimony be extended to June 3, 2013. In support of its motion, the Public Staff states that it has reached an agreement in principle with Duke settling the issues in this proceeding and needs additional time to prepare the stipulation and accompanying testimony or affidavits. In addition, the Public Staff states that the other parties to this docket have no objection to the Public Staff's motion for further extensions of time.

Based on the Public Staff's motion and the record in this docket, the Chairman is of the opinion that good cause exists to grant the requested further extensions of time.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED that the time for filing petitions to intervene and the testimony and exhibits of expert witnesses of the Public Staff and intervenors is extended to May 31, 2013, and the time for filing Duke's rebuttal testimony is extended to June 3, 2013.
