BY THE CHAIR: The above-captioned docket is a rulemaking proceeding on access to electric customer usage data. On February 5, 2024, Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC, and Duke Energy Progress, LLC (collectively, Duke) filed a Joint Motion for Leave to File Sur-Reply Comments. The Motion requested leave for all parties to file sur-reply comments on or before April 5, 2024, for the limited purpose of addressing new issues raised in the previously filed supplemental reply comments. This motion was granted by the Commission on February 19, 2024. On April 4, 2024, Duke filed a motion requesting an extension of time to April 19, 2024, for all parties to file sur-reply comments. Counsel for Duke represents that counsel for the parties that filed supplemental reply comments and other parties were contacted about the requested extension, and no party objected.

Based on Duke's Motion and the record, the Chair finds good cause to grant Duke's Motion for extension of time for all parties to file sur-reply comments through and including April 19, 2024.
