BY THE CHAIR: On June 27, 2019, Pinnacle Bank, as successor by merger with Bank of North Carolina (Complainant), through counsel, filed a Motion for Extension of Time (Motion) in the above-captioned proceeding. In the Motion, Complainant informs the Commission, among other things, that it was directed to request a hearing or file a reply in the docket by July 1, 2019. Complainant also informs the Commission that the Parties are continuing to discuss the dispute. The Parties, however, need additional time to exchange information relevant to the issues raised in the Complaint, and Complainant needs more time to review and any such newly exchanged information once provided by Respondent. Complainant has informed Respondent of the motion and Respondent consents to the extension of time.

The Chair has reviewed the record, including Complainant's motion, and finds that good cause exists to grant an extension of time from July 1, 2019, to July 31, 2019, to request a hearing or file a rely in the proceeding.
