BY THE PRESIDING COMMISSIONER: On August 13, 2019, the Commission held a hearing in the above-captioned docket regarding an annual review of the gas costs of Public Service Company of North Carolina, Inc. (PSNC). Briefs and proposed orders of the parties were due on October 3, 2019.

On October 3, 2019, PSNC filed a motion requesting that the date for the filing of briefs and proposed orders be extended to October 17, 2019. In summary, PSNC stated that the Public Staff and PSNC need additional time to work through points of agreement for the proposed order. In addition, PSNC stated that the Public Staff and Carolina Utility Customers Association, Inc., the only other party to this proceeding, stated that they do not object to the requested extension of time.

Based on PSNC's motion and the record, the Presiding Commissioner finds good cause to extend the due date for all parties to file briefs and proposed orders to October 17, 2019.
