respect to matters coming before us this morning? 1 2 (No response) 3 The record will reflect that no conflicts have been identified, so we will proceed with Public 4 5 Staff, Natural Gas Item P1. 6 MS. PATEL: Good morning. I'm Neha Patel with the Public Staff's Energy Division. 7 Item P1 is 8 Docket G-5, Sub 636, an Application filed by Public 9 Service Company of North Carolina requesting authority 10 to adjust its rates effective September 1st, 2021, 11 under Rider E of the Company's tariff pursuant it's 12 Integrity Management Tracker Mechanism. 13 PSNC is required to file a revision to its 14 tariff for Commission approval by February 15th and 15 August 15th each year showing the computation of the 16 Integrity Management adjustment that it proposes to 17 charge during six-month period between March 1st and 18 September 1st respectively. 19 On July 30th, 2021, PSNC filed in Docket 20 G-5, Sub 565C the computation for the IMRR that 21 supports the bi-annual IM rate adjustments based on 22 the Company's IM plant investment through June 30, 23 2021. 24 The proposed IMT rate adjustment table

expressed in dollars per therm is as shown in the 1 2 table. 3 The Public Staff has reviewed the proposed rate adjustments and recommends approval as filed, and 4 5 a proposed order is attached as Exhibit P-1. 14	of the TRS service, Telecommunications Relay Service
15	Program. At Staff Conference on October 26th, 2020,
16	the Public Staff presented findings of DHHS's
17	evaluation of the TRS RFP bids and presented and
18	the Commission approved the DHHS's election of Sprint
19	as the vendor for relay services for the four-year
20	period beginning January 1st, 2021 and ending on
21	December 31st, 2024. The contract bid was for a total
22	cost of \$5,700,480.00 over the life of the contract.
23	DHHS excuse me, I'm sorry. And the Commission
24	issued an Order approving the DHHS's selection.

1	On July 21st, 2021, DHHS filed a letter with
2	the Commission to provide notice of a need for a
3	contract extension and asked that the contract period
4	be changed from January 1st, 2021 through
5	December 30th 31st, 2024, instead to be July 1st,
6	2021 through June 30th, 2025, and to increase the
7	total contract cost to \$6,084,400. DHHS stated that
8	this change in contract period is necessary to align
9	the 2016 contract termination date with the start of
10	the approval Order.
11	Regarding the increased total contract cost,
12	DHHS explained that the change in the total contract
13	cost is required by the Statewide IT Procurement
14	Office and is a result of their effort to address the
15	estimated RCC usage. RCC is the Relay Conference
16	Captioning portion of their service. They stated that
17	it was because of the pandemic and the expanded use of
18	this service, the actual bid award made by the
19	Statewide IT Procurement Office is \$6,084,400.
20	The Public Staff's Accounting Division has
21	reviewed the TRS surcharge monthly reports and
22	determined that the reserve account balance, with the
23	current rate being \$0.08 per access line, is

24 sufficient to absorb the increase in the contract

amending the order to increase the total contract cost 2 3 will not create the need for a TRS surcharge rate change. Further, the Public Staff sees no harm in 4 5 amending the previously approved contract period as 6 requested by the DHHS in its July 21st letter to the Commission. 7 8 A copy of our proposed order is attached as 9 Exhibit P-2. The Public Staff recommends that the 10 11 Commission issue an amended order increasing the total 12 contract cost to \$6,084,400 and changing the contract 13 period to the four-year period beginning July 1st, 14 2021 and ending June 30th, 2025. 15 I do have someone here available to answer 16 any questions if you need from the DHHS. 17 COMMISSIONER BROWN-BLAND: I move approval 18 of the recommendation. 19 COMMISSIONER GRAY: Second. 20 CHAIR MITCHELL: It's been moved and 21 seconded that the item be approved as recommended by 22 the Public Staff.
