BY THE COMMISSION: On August 15, 2016, the Commission issued its Order Amending Commission Rule R15-1 in this docket. The Commission concluded that it was appropriate to adopt revised Commission Rule R15-1- Regulatory Fee as reflected in Appendix B of the Order.

The Commission inadvertently included the phrase “intrastate switched” in the definition of noncompetitive jurisdictional revenues as referenced in Commission Rule R15-1(c)(1). Commission Rule R15-1(c)(1) should read:


(1) "Noncompetitive jurisdictional revenues" means all revenues derived or realized from intrastate tariffs, rates, and charges approved or allowed by the Commission or collected pursuant to Commission order or rule, but not including tap-on fees or any other form of contributions in aid of construction. For telecommunications companies, all revenues and other receipts derived from access charges are to be included as noncompetitive jurisdictional revenues.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED that Commission Rule R15-1(c)(1) is hereby revised as indicated above, effective August 15, 2016.
