This letter is written in opposition to the establishment of a 20 MW Solar Generating facility power plant off of US Highway #301 in Halifax County between the towns of Weldon and Halifax.

My objections are as follows:

- No scientific studies have been done showing short and long term health impacts on people in neighborhoods adjacent to these types of facilities.

Who is responsible for damages done to adjacent properties, should they occur, and what guarantees do we have that the responsible parties will fulfill their obligations?

What impact will this facility have on adjacent property values in this predominately "Black" property owned area?

Why is the disruption of the quality of life necessary for many "black" NC citizens
To support a project that benefits one "Mega" white land owner for power generating
Where usage of the power is not clearly defined?

The selection of this site appears to be nothing more than an attempt to devalue "Black Owned" properties adjacent to the proposed project site.
