~~This bill was to Carolina Water Service for \$83.26 for water & sewer between 2/2 - 3/4/19 for a cost of \$83.26 or \$.066608/gallon as I only used 1250 gallons.~~

Now you approved a cost increase for Carolina Water Service to start 4-1-19!

CAN you please explain WHY CWS is charging SO MUCH MORE/gallon?

Do they get more profit than Union County?  
Are they more inefficient & need more money to stay afloat?
