BY THE CHAIRMAN: On November 14, 2011, FLS Owner II, LLC (FLS), filed a registration statement pursuant to Commission Rule R8-66 for a new renewable energy facility to be located at the Hampton Inn in Hendersonville in Henderson County, North Carolina. FLS stated that its 32,000 Btu/hr metered solar thermal facility, consisting of 24 solar panels, was expected to become operational on or around December, 2011.

The filing included certified attestations that: 1) the facility is in substantial compliance with all federal and state laws, regulations, and rules for the protection of the environment and conservation of natural resources; 2) the facility will be operated as a new renewable energy facility; 3) FLS will not remarket or otherwise resell any renewable energy certificates (RECs) sold to an electric power supplier to comply with G.S. 62-133.8; and 4) FLS will consent to the auditing of its books and records by the Public Staff insofar as those records relate to transactions with North Carolina electric power suppliers.

On January 26, 2012, the Public Staff filed the recommendation required by Commission Rule R8-66(e) stating that FLS's registration statement as a new renewable energy facility should be considered to be complete. No other party made a filing with respect to these issues.

Based upon the foregoing and the entire record in this proceeding, the Chairman finds good cause to accept registration of FLS's metered solar thermal facility as a new renewable energy facility. FLS shall annually file the information required by Commission Rule R8-66 on or before April 1 of each year. FLS will be required to participate in the NC-RETS REC tracking system (<http://www.ncrets.org>) in order to facilitate the issuance of RECs.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED as follows:

1. That the registration by FLS for its metered solar thermal facility located at the Hampton Inn in Hendersonville in Henderson County, North Carolina as a new renewable energy facility shall be, and is hereby, accepted.

2. That FLS shall annually file the information required by Commission Rule R8-66 on or before April 1 of each year.
