NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on February 25, 2015, Flowers Solar, LLC (Applicant), filed an application seeking a certificate of public convenience and necessity pursuant to G.S. 62-110.1(a) for construction of a 4.998-MW solar generating facility to be located on the east side of Baileys Crossroads Road, south of the intersection with Chic Ennis Road and north of the intersection with Hilda Dr. in Benson, Harnett County, North Carolina. The Applicant plans to sell the electricity to Duke Energy Progress, Inc.

If no complaint is received within the time specified above and if the Commission does not order a hearing upon its own initiative, the Commission will enter an order awarding the certificate sought by the Applicant.
