BY THE PRESIDING COMMISSIONER: On March 23, 2023, in the above-captioned proceeding the Commission issued its Order Approving Revised Net Metering Tariffs.

On April 19, 2023, Environmental Working Group, 350 Triangle, 350 Charlotte, the North Carolina Alliance to Protect Our People and Places We Live, NC WARN, North Carolina Climate Solutions Coalition, and Sunrise Movement Durham Hub (collectively, Joint Movants) filed a Joint Motion for an Extension of Time to File Notice of Appeal and Exceptions pursuant to N.C. Gen. Stat. § 62-90(a) seeking an additional 30 days to appeal the March 23, 2023 Order. Joint Movants state that the issues presented in this docket are complex and justify careful consideration and Joint Movants need additional time to adequately assess whether to file a notice of appeal and exceptions to the Order.

The Presiding Commissioner finds that good cause exists to grant all parties the requested extension of time up to and including May 22, 2023, within which to file notice of appeal and exceptions in this proceeding.
