BY THE PRESIDING COMMISSIONER: On June 7, 2022, as amended on June 30, 2022, Duke Energy Progress, LLC (DEP), filed a request with the Commission for a waiver of the June 1 annual deadline required by Commission Rule R8-67(h)(11) for the entry of North Carolina retail sales per megawatt-hour (retail sales data) in NC-RETS, for Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC (DEC), DEP, and the wholesale customers for which DEC and DEP perform Renewable Energy and Energy Efficiency Portfolio Standards (REPS) compliance services.

In its motion, DEP states that on June 3, 2022, after a slight delay for verification of its data, it completed entry of its annual retail sales data for itself and the five wholesale customers for which it provides REPS compliance services. DEP further explains that it encountered functionality issues with NC-RETS when trying to add a new wholesale customer. On June 30, DEP notified the Commission that it would not be providing REPS compliance service for an additional wholesale customer, and DEP entered its own 2021 retail sales data in NC-RETS on June 28, 2022.

The Presiding Commissioner has carefully considered DEP's request and, based on the foregoing and the entire record in this proceeding, finds good cause to grant DEP's request for a waiver of the June 1 deadline required by Commission Rule R8-67(h)(11). Further, the Clerk's Office shall deliver a copy of this Order to the NC-RETS Administrator.
