Thank you for providing the Division of Water Resources (DWR) an opportunity to provide comments regarding the Application of SolNCPower5 Solar, LLC for Certificate to construct a 5 MW Solar Photovoltaic Electric Generating Facility in Nash Co.

DWR has no objection to the proposed project, but offer the following comments from Danny Smith of the Raleigh Regional Office:

- 1. If land disturbance exceeds 1 acre, an erosion and sedimentation control plan should be secured. Additionally, compliance with construction stormwater permit conditions (NCG010000) will be required
- 2. Be advised that construction activities with impacts to wetlands and streams will require review by this Office and may require issuance of a 401 Water Quality Certification and Tar-Pamlico riparian buffer authorization.
- 3. This Office recommends coordinating with the United States Army Corps of Engineers (USACOE) concerning identification of any jurisdictional features and the required permitting that may be involved prior to the implementation of this project.


