



Commission granted the Parties' request and issued an Order Canceling Public Witness Hearing.

Based upon the foregoing, the Chair hereby establishes a revised procedural schedule, including filing requirements of Currituck, the Public Staff, and other parties. The discovery guidelines established in the CPCN Scheduling Order shall apply to the revised procedural schedule set forth herein.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED as follows:

1. That a hearing for the purpose of receiving expert witness testimony on Currituck's CPCN Application is scheduled to begin at 2:00 p.m., on Tuesday, October 29, 2024, and continuing as necessary until conclusion. The hearing will be held in Commission Hearing Room 2115, Dobbs Building, 430 North Salisbury Street, Raleigh, North Carolina 27603;

2. That the parties shall comply with the discovery guidelines established in the February 14, 2024 CPCN Scheduling Order and shall work in a cooperative manner as to discovery;

3. That petitions to intervene in this proceeding shall be filed pursuant to Commission Rules R1-5 and R1-19 no later than Thursday, September 19, 2024;

4. That Currituck's prefiled direct testimony and exhibits shall be filed on or before Wednesday, August 28, 2024;

5. That the Public Staff's and other intervenors' prefiled direct testimony and exhibits shall be filed on or before Thursday, September 19, 2024;

6. That Currituck's prefiled rebuttal testimony and exhibits, if any, shall be filed on or before Wednesday, October 9, 2024;

7. That an officer or representative from Currituck is required to appear before the Commission at the time and place of the expert witness hearing to testify concerning any of the information contained in the CPCN Application;

8. That any parties filing supporting exhibits in Excel format shall provide the Commission Staff electronic versions of the exhibits filed in native Excel format via email at [NCUCexhibits@ncuc.net](mailto:NCUCexhibits@ncuc.net), including all of the supporting tabs and formulas, within three days of the filing of such exhibits (or within three days of the issuance of this order if already filed with the Commission); and that any parties filing exhibits and workpapers that include tables of numbers and calculations shall provide the Public Staff and any other party upon request an electronic version of all such exhibits and workpapers, with formulas intact; and

9. That Currituck shall consult with all other parties and file, no later than Thursday, October 24, 2024, a list of witnesses to be called at the expert witness hearing, the order of witnesses, and each party's estimated time for cross-examination. If the parties cannot agree, the remaining parties shall, no later than noon on Monday, October 28, 2024, make a filing indicating their points of disagreement with Currituck's filing.
