BY THE CHAIR: On March 11, 2022, the Commission issued an Order Opening Separate Dockets and Establishing Procedural Deadlines (Order) which established these dockets for the purpose of considering Duke Energy Progress, LLC's and Duke Energy Carolina, LLC's (collectively Duke) Petition for Authorization of 2022 Solar Procurement Program (Petition) pursuant to Session Law 2021-165, Section 2(c.). Of relevance, the Order set a deadline for Duke to file reply comments of Monday, April 4, 2022.

On March 31, 2022, Duke filed a motion requesting a two-day extension of time to file its reply comments. In support of its motion, Duke states that they "are working diligently to develop their reply comments in this matter. However, due to ongoing work related to numerous proceedings, including other proceedings to implement Session Law 2021-165, [Duke requires] additional time to sufficiently address the initial comments of the seven intervenors, the Public Staff, and Attorney General's Office." Further, Duke states that "the requested extension will not result in prejudice to any party[,]" and that no other party objects to the motion.

Having considered Duke's motion, the Commission finds good cause to allow the requested extension of time.

IT IS, THEREFORE, SO ORDERED.
