Dear Ms. Jarvis:

Pursuant to Ordering Paragraph 3 of the *Order Approving Merger Subject to Regulatory Conditions and Code of Conduct* and Paragraph 2 of the *Agreement and Stipulation of Settlement Between the Applicants, Transco and the Public Staff, Public Service Company of North Carolina, Incorporated* (“PSNC”) was required to record a regulatory liability of \$3.75 million and refund that amount to its customers through bill credits of \$1.25 million each on January 1, 2019 (or as soon thereafter as possible), January 1, 2020 and January 1, 2021. PSNC created a regulatory liability as required and subsequently applied credits to customers’ February 2019 bills. Schedule A attached hereto sets forth the credits applied to each rate schedule.
