BY THE PRESIDING COMMISSIONER: On July 7, 2021, the Commission issued a Scheduling Order in the above-captioned docket that, among other things, scheduled an expert witness hearing on Tuesday, September 21, 2021.

On September 17, 2021, Duke Energy Progress, LLC (DEP), jointly North Carolina Justice Center, Southern Alliance for Clean Energy, and North Carolina Housing Coalition (NCJC, *et al.*), and the Public Staff (collectively, Movants), filed a joint motion requesting that the Commission excuse DEP witness Shannon R. Listebarger and Public Staff witness Michael C. Maness from testifying at the expert witness hearing. Movants stated that all parties have agreed to waive cross-examination of these two witnesses and offer no objection to the introduction of the witnesses' testimony and exhibits into the record.

Based on the foregoing and the record, the Presiding Commissioner finds good cause to grant Movants' motion to excuse DEP witness Shannon R. Listebarger and Public Staff witness Michael C. Maness from attending the expert witness hearing on September 21, 2021, and to receive their testimony and exhibits into evidence at the hearing.

IT IS, THEREFORE, SO ORDERED.
