Dear Ms. Dunston:

Please accept this letter for filing in the above-captioned dockets as Water Resources, Inc.'s Second Status Report on Compliance with Meter Replacement Requirement.

The purpose of this letter is to provide a further update to the Commission on the progress that Water Resources, Inc. ("Water Resources") made to comply with Ordering Paragraph No. 1 of the Commission's *Order Ruling on Motion for Clarification, Holding Complaint in Abeyance, and Requiring Public Staff investigation*, which was issued in the above-captioned docket on September 21, 2021. On February 18, 2022, Water Resources filed a letter regarding the status of compliance with the meter replacement requirement of the Commission's September 21, 2021 Order. That letter stated, in summary, that as of February 18, 2022, all meters in Rocky River Plantation have been replaced, except two, and that those two remaining meters were scheduled to be replaced the following day (February 19, 2022). Finally, the letter stated that if the replacement of the final two meters was not accomplished on February 19, 2022, Water Resources would provide a further update to the Commission.

For the avoidance of doubt and confusion, and for the sake of having a full record in this proceeding, Water Resources provides this second status report on compliance with the meter replacement requirement. The remaining two meters referenced in Water Resources' letter dated February 18, 2022, were replaced on February 19, 2022, two days prior to the deadline established by the Commission. Thus, Water Resources believes and will assume, absent further direction from the Commission, that this requirement has been satisfied.
