Dear Clerk Mount:

This filing is an amendment to the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity in the above-referenced docket pursuant to Rule R8-64(d)(3). The Order Granting Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to SunEnergy1, LLC ("SunEnergy1") became effective on November 15, 2013.

The solar facility is currently under construction. Due to siting constraints, the layout of the facility requires additional land for the facility to be constructed to the certificated capacity of 12-MW_{AC}. SunEnergy1 has entered into a site control agreement with Richard Anderson for additional land for the facility.

Enclosed and marked as <u>SunEnergy1 Amendment: Exhibit 1</u> is an amended location map which reflects the project boundary with the additional land. Also enclosed and marked as <u>SunEnergy1 Amendment: Exhibit 2</u> is an amended proposed layout which reflects the facility footprint on the additional land. The location description for the facility, taking into consideration the amended layout, is on the north side of Watson Seed Farm Road at the intersection of Bellamy Mill Road in Whitakers, North Carolina.

Due to the change in the footprint of the facility, we understand the Commission will enter an Order Requiring Publication of a Public Notice and direct the Clerk to forward the amended application to the Clearinghouse. SunEnergy1 is continuing construction of the portion of the facility on land reflected in the site layout filed with the application for the certificate from which the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity was granted. SunEnergy1 will not begin construction on any portion of the facility to be sited on the additional property being added to the project boundary unless and until an Order Amending the Certificate of Public Convenience to address this filing is entered.
