Mr. Stuebe,

The NC Utilities Commission has received and filed the Notifications of e911 Address Assignments submitted by Ecoplexus in the above-referenced dockets. The submission of this information is appreciated by the Commission, and fulfills the requirements of Commission Rule R8-64(d)(3) to keep the Commission informed of changes regarding these facilities.

In these filings, you also request that the Commission issue an amended Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity and Registration (CPCNs) to reflect the updated e911 addresses. In the past, the Commission has issued amended CPCNs to update e911 addresses. However, these updates to the address of the facility are generally minor changes that do not affect or change the actual location of the facility. Therefore, in recent months the Commission has determined that it is sufficient to note the e911 address update on its records, without the need to issue an amended CPCN.

Nevertheless, if there is a particular circumstance or need that makes it important to have the CPCNs amended in these dockets, please let me know.
