Pursuant to the Demand-Side Management and Energy Efficiency ("DSM/EE") Program Flexibility Guidelines, approved initially by the Commission in its July 16, 2012 *Order Adopting Program Flexibility Guidelines* ("July 2012 Order") in Docket No. E-7, Sub 831 and subsequently applied to the new portfolio of programs approved in the Commission's October 29, 2013 *Order Approving DSM/EE Programs and Stipulation of Settlement* ("October 2013 Order") in Docket No. E-7, Sub 1032, enclosed please find Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC's ("DEC" or the "Company") Advance Notice Program Notification Reporting Template for the Residential Energy Efficiency Education Program ("Program"), reflecting the removal of measures to be effective November 23, 2023.

The Program was initially approved in the Commission's October 2013 Order. Through this Program the Company educates K-12 students about energy and conveys the impact that students can have by becoming more energy efficient and using energy and resources more wisely. In conjunction with teachers and administrators, the Company will continue to provide educational materials and curriculum for targeted schools and grades. Included in those materials is an energy efficiency kit containing certain energy saving measures to be installed in the customer's home. The Company is removing lightbulbs from the kit based on changing lighting standards. To continue to generate energy savings for the Program, the Company is reworking the kit to include measures such as aerators, weatherstripping, refrigerator thermometer, and a furnace whistle.


As the changes to the Program for schools do not require Commission approval, in accordance with Flexibility Guidelines, this filing is for informational purposes only.


