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NOW COMES Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC ("DEC" or the "Company"), pursuant to Rule R1-7 of the Rules and Regulations of the North Carolina Utilities Commission ("Commission"), and moves the Commission for a seven-day extension of time through and including October 18, 2021 to file revised billing factors and the proposed Customer Notice as required by the Commission's September 10, 2021 *Order Approving DSM/EE Rider and Requiring Filing of Proposed Customer Notice*. In support of the foregoing, the Company shows the Commission the following:

1. On September 10, 2021, the Commission issued the *Order Approving DSM/EE Rider and Requiring Filing of Proposed Customer Notice* (the "Order") which, among other things, required DEC to work with the Public Staff of the North Carolina Utilities Commission ("Public Staff") to calculate the billing factors impacted by the removal of the Find It Duke revenues and costs excluded by the Order. The Order also required DEC and the Public Staff to develop a proposed Customer Notice explaining the rate changes and to file the revised billing factors and proposed Customer Notice within 30

days. Since October 10, 2021 falls on the weekend, the filing is currently due October 11, 2021.


2. DEC and the Public Staff are working diligently to calculate the revised billing factors and develop the Customer Notice but require additional time to calculate the revised billing factors. Based on the foregoing, and ongoing discussions with the Public Staff, the Company respectfully requests an extension of seven days up to and including October 18, 2021, to file revised billing factors and the proposed Customer Notice in this proceeding.

3. The requested extension will not result in prejudice to any party.

4. Counsel for the Company has contacted counsel for all parties of record regarding this Motion, and no party has advised that it objects.

WHEREFORE, Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC respectfully requests that the Commission grant this Motion for an extension of time, through and including October 18, 2021, to file revised billing factors and the proposed Customer Notice in this proceeding, and such other relief as the Commission deems just and proper.


