BY THE PRESIDING COMMISSIONER: On January 28, 2022, the Commission issued an order scheduling a hearing on April 4, 2022, as a continuation of the evidentiary hearing held on November 30, 2021. On February 8, 2022, in response to a motion filed by the Applicant, the Commission issued an Order Rescheduling Hearing rescheduling the evidentiary hearing to March 2, 2022, maintaining the deadline for proposed orders and briefs in this case as February 11, 2022, and establishing a deadline of March 7, 2022, for the parties to file any revised and redlined proposed orders and briefs.

During the hearing on March 2, 2022, the Commission asked the parties to file supplemental briefs in addition to their revised, redlined proposed orders. On March 4, 2022, the Public Staff filed a Motion for Extension of Time to File Proposed Orders and Supplemental Briefs requesting that the parties have until Wednesday, March 9, 2022, to file their revised briefs and proposed orders. The Public Staff states that because of the short deadline, the amount of testimony presented at the March 2, 2022, evidentiary hearing, and the complexity of the issues to be briefed, the Public Staff requires additional time to revise its proposed order and brief the requested issue. The Public Staff states that a two-day extension will provide it with sufficient time to revise its proposed order and draft the supplemental brief. The Public Staff states that it has contacted counsel for the Applicant and Duke and neither party objects to the motion.

Considering the foregoing, the Presiding Commissioner finds good cause to grant the extension until Wednesday, March 9, 2022, for the parties to file briefs and revised proposed orders.

IT IS, THEREFORE, SO ORDERED.
