BY THE PRESIDING COMMISSIONER: On November 5, 2015, the Commission issued an Order in Docket No. E-100, Sub 141 that, among other things, requested parties to file comments and reply comments in Docket No. E-100, Sub 126 regarding proposed amendments to Commission Rule R8-60.1(c). On December 1, 2015, several parties filed proposed amendments and/or comments. Reply comments are due on January 8, 2016.

On January 5, 2016, the Public Staff filed a motion requesting that the date for reply comments be extended to January 29, 2016. The Public Staff states, among other things, that the parties have scheduled a meeting for January 14, 2016, to discuss their positions and attempt to reach a consensus position on the proposed amendments to Rule R8-60.1. In addition, the Public Staff states that Dominion North Carolina Power, Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC, Duke Energy Progress, LLC, and North Carolina Sustainable Energy Association support the motion for extension of time.


