

Dear Sir,

I am a Wake County resident who invested in rooftop solar last April, counting on net metering. The system was expensive but I felt I was 1) contributing to the energy needs and efficiency of my nation, 2) allowing myself some control and contribution to my own energy needs and costs which are otherwise totally monopolized by the growing Duke Progress Corporation and 3) it would be cost effective over time. To my understanding all these positive results depend on the continuation of net metering.

Therefore, I DO NOT support changes to net metering that will kill rooftop solar in North Carolina. (Docket E-100, Sub 83: Net Metering)
