- (1) Budgeted 2021 reflects YTD 2021 results through 3Q 2021, plus budgeted 4Q 2021.
- (a) Ferry and Parking operations moved from Indigo Plantation Terminal facilities to Deep Point Terminal Facilities in June 2009.
- (b) In 2010, the regulated utility concluded a rate case with the North Carolina Utilities Commission. New Ticket classes and tariffs became effective January 1, 2011. Ferry Ticket prices have not changed since January 2001.
- (c) NCUC Facilities Lease expense of \$1,252,708 annually. NCUC Facilities Lease, and all underlying real estate associated with the lease, is being purchased. Expense extinguished at Closing.
- (d) 2021 and 2020 Preliminary Financials Prior to audit, tax and non-cash accounting adjustments and reconciliations.
- (e) Hurricane Florence (September 2018) had significant effects on Tug & Freight Barge operations during the Q4 2018 -to- Q2 2019 period.
- (f) Covid-19 Pandemic adversely effected revenue and operations from March 2020-to-March 2021. Beginning March 2020, all ferries adhered to reduced capacity limitations as imposed by the NCUC and NC Governor.
- (g) Bald Head Island Transportation, Inc. was the beneficiary of a \$496,300 PPP Loan from the SBA. Loan proceeds were received on May 4, 2020 and the loan was completely forgiven on December 9, 2020.
- (h) Effective July 22, 2019, Barge Ticket Rates were increased for the first time since 2006. Barge Ticket Rates were increased by \$5.00 from \$50.00 to \$55.00 per 6ft. length.
- (i) Effective July 22, 2019, Daily Parking Rates were increased for the first time since 2009. General Lot Daily Rates and Contractor Lot Daily Rates were increased by \$1.00. Annual and Seasonal Parking Rates did not change.
- (j) Effective June 14, 2021, Barge Ticket Rates were increased by \$5.00 from \$55.00 to \$60.00 per 6ft. length.
- (k) Effective June 14, 2021, General Lot Daily Rates and Contractor Lot Daily Rates were increased by \$1.00. Annual and Seasonal Parking Rates did not change.
- (I) Historical financials do not account for increased Salaries & Wages projected during the hold period. This expense increase will be offset by cost savings associated with the NCUC lease being extinguished.
