NOW COMES INGENCO Wholesale Power, LLC ("INGENCO"), by and through the undersigned counsel and pursuant to the Commission's *Order Requiring Periodic Reports on Status of Natural Gas Projects and Opening New Docket*, which was issued in this proceeding on November 18, 2022, and submits the following responses to the Commission's questions in Appendix A of that Order, as relevant to INGENCO's renewable natural gas ("RNG") facility located at the Tuscarora Landfill in New Bern, North Carolina ("the RNG Facility at New Bern"), which was approved for participation in the Piedmont Appendix F RNG pilot program pursuant to the Commission's *Order Approving Participation in Pilot Program with Conditions*, issued in Docket No. G-9, Sub 698 on June 21, 2022. INGENCO respectfully requests that the Commission accept the following responses to the Commission's questions constituting this First Periodic Report of INGENCO Wholesale Power, LLC:

Question 1. Describe the types of RNG (landfill gas, swine waste, poultry waste, etc.), the percentage of each type of RNG, and the quantities and pressures of RNG to be supplied at all interconnection points and injection points (collectively, interconnection points).

Response: The RNG facility at New Bern is designed to process solely from landfill gas from the Tuscarora Landfill in New Bern, North Carolina.

Question 2. State the number of farms and other providers that have been contracted with to provide RNG.

Response: The RNG Facility at New Bern is designed to process landfill gas solely from the Tuscarora Landfill in New Bern, North Carolina.

Question 3. Provide the details of your plans for selling RNG, including: (a) The name(s) and location(s) of the buyers, (b) whether the buyer(s) will be end users of the RNG or will resell it to another entity, and (c) the manner in which the price of the RNG will be determined.

Response: INGENCO plans to sell RNG produced at the RNG Facility at New Bern to one or more counterparties with experience in the transportation, storage and utilization of RNG that are customer(s) receiving natural gas service from Piedmont.

Question 4. Describe the status of any negotiations with Piedmont for entering into a receipt interconnect agreement (RIA), and state when you anticipate entering into a RIA.

Response: INGENCO is in conversations with Piedmont regarding the timeline for the construction of interconnection facilities that will allow the RNG Facility at New Bern to inject RNG into Piedmont's pipeline. INGENCO and Piedmont are in discussions on an approximate location of the proposed interconnection location, subject to finalization through the Receipt Interconnection Agreement. Once details are finalized, Piedmont and INGENCO will negotiate and execute the associated Receipt Interconnection Agreement.

Question 5. Describe the current construction status of your RNG facility.

Response: The RNG Facility at New Bern has not yet started construction.

Question 6. State the projected date for commercial operation of your RNG facility.

Response: Subject to internal financial approvals and permitting INGENCO is planning for the RNG Facility at New Bern to enter commercial operation in Q1 2024.

WHEREFORE INGENCO respectfully requests that the Commission accept this First Periodic Report of INGENCO Wholesale Power, LLC in compliance with the Commission's Order Requiring Periodic Reports on Status of Natural Gas Projects and Opening New Docket.
