BY THE CHAIR: On January 27, 2023, Duke Energy Progress, LLC (DEP), and Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC (DEC; together with DEP, Duke) filed a petition requesting Commission approval of the Clean Energy Impact Program (CEI Program). The CEI Program would allow customers to reduce their carbon footprint or support renewable energy by purchasing Renewable Energy Certificates (RECs) bundled with carbon emission attributes associated with the generation, or Clean Energy Environmental Attributes (CEEAs). Duke states in its petition that the CEI Program is one of several new programs it will propose to fulfil the directives of Section 5 of S.L. 2021-165 to offer voluntary renewable energy programs.

Based on the petition, the Chair finds good cause to request comments and reply comments from interested parties regarding Duke's proposed CEI Program.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED as follows:

- 1. That on or before March 28, 2023, persons having an interest in this matter may file petitions to intervene in this docket;
- 2. That on or before March 28, 2023, the Public Staff and intervenors may file initial comments regarding Duke's proposed CEI Program; and
- 3. That on or before April 11, 2023, all parties may file reply comments regarding Duke's proposed CEI Program.
